Prioritise your expenses
(budgeting for irregular incomes)

Write a list of ALL your expenses in order - starting with the highest priority to the lowest priority.

To do this, get out a copy of your household budget.

Look through each of your expenses and start by writing down the highest priority (e.g. your mortgage payment or rent).

You are likely to leave things like spending money, coffee money, and allocations for clothes etc at the bottom of the list.

To re cap, the purpose is to help you prioritise what expenses need to be paid FIRST in a month where your income falls short of your average monthly income.
